The proposed tollway will destroy Ross Straw field and West Parkville with huge flyovers joining City Link. It will ruin the wetlands and sports fields. It will butcher the park from Flemington Road to

Royal Parade with huge on/off ramps into Elliot Avenue. It will pump pollution into the "lungs of the city"

It will take priceless parkland that can never be replaced.
